For Everyone: God's Free Gift

Using the Bible as our point of reference, we considered our relationship to God, examining our origin, our value and our eternity. The Bible offers information and comfort.

We seek comfort for jaded nerves and short-fused tempers, for helpless and worthless feelings, for strength to get through the night, for tomorrow.

“Be still and know that I am God.” I need that. I also needed to spend time with a Christian Brother, examining the foundation of our faith. To reaffirm that for descendants of Adam and Eve, there is no hope, no peace, no eternal joy apart from the blood of Jesus.

Praise God. Jesus, on Calvary paid the debt to redeem us. He took care of everything. It remains for us to repent and come to Him, accepting His offer, and yielding to His authority as Sovereign Lord.

We paused to reflect on the moral tone of our country and our world. Our conversation examined human relations. We compared and contrasted. We searched for understanding, for encouragement.

We examined sin, Biblical sin as in David, Peter, Paul; adultery, murder, cursing the name of Jesus, killing Christians – the horrible reality of life.

We looked at God's love toward us. “While we were yet sinners Christ died for us.” That is the point, our focus. God loves us, in spite of our past, in spite of our weaknesses, in spite of our fear of the future. God loves us

Calvary cleared our slate, our guilt. The blood of Jesus paid our sin debt. God sees believers washed clean through the blood of Jesus, making us holy before God.

We examined Biblical anger. Job helped. We catch our breath as Job shows his anger. He insists he is not guilty. He is loyal to God. He hates what is happening to him. He doesn't understand it but can't do anything about it.

Job questioned God; not to accuse or find fault, but to understand the why of his circumstances. Why this? Why me?

His friends see the visible pain. They think they understand. "God is punishing you. You have sinned."

Job shouts back. He wants to meet God face-to-face. He wants answers to the why of his situation!

The surprising conclusion to Job's plight is that God says Job is OK. Job is acceptable to God. Job is righteous. What? All that anger? Yes. All that questioning? Yes. God knows Job's heart.

We thought about the knowledge of God. How much does He know about me? When did He first know me? In His sight, who am I? The Bible says God knew me before conception; before my parents were acquainted. God knows everything about me, my origin, my present, my eternity. He created me in His image and He loves me!

Scary? Sure. Psalm 139 tells us that we cannot hide from God. He is Omnipotent, Omniscient and Omnipresent. He is The Creator of everything. He created man in His image. This is bad news for the sinner. For Christians that is the best news ever. We are never out of His sight. Never!

God is love. Remember? He created us. We belong to Him. We rest in the comfort of His love, His protection, His leading.

So, what happens when trouble hits? Why does God allow us to be hurt?

Revisit Job. Ask why for information to help understand. Understand, God is holy and righteous. He knows what we can handle, emotionally, physically and spiritually. For His purpose, as with Job, when God allows difficulties for us, He has already provided everything we need to overcome it.

God gave us **free will**. We choose. His promise to all who yield to His Lordship is that nothing can separate us from His love! Nothing, except our free will. **Free will** requires that a believer **must choose** to be lost. He must choose to leave God, rejecting all His mercies, and completely turn away from following Him.

Study the life of Judas Iscariot. Judas, one of the twelve with all privileges and opportunities. Yet he chose money over the eternal love of Jesus.

The bottom line: I am a sinner saved by His grace. God's great love redeemed me on Calvary. My part was accepting God's offer. His gift was/is free to me, to you and to everyone who chooses to repent, accept His Lordship, turn from sin and come to Him to be saved from His eternal wrath in hell.

Amen. Come Lord Jesus!
